Pine Creek Sporting Club opened in November of 2008, offering twenty-two, 40-acre ranch sites ranging in price from \$800,000 to \$1,200,000. One of the early purchasers of a ranchsite is Tricia Quick of Palm Beach, who sees Pine Creek as an ideal opportunity to enjoy an entirely different world barely an hour away.

“It’s the perfect weekend getaway for my son and me,” Quick said. “Where else can we invite our friends to share quality time in the outdoors with our kids these days? Pine Creek is a nostalgic piece of American heritage that has been long forgotten in the modern world.”

Champion shooter Mick Howells designed the world-class sporting clay course that features over 40 throwers and offers challenges at both intermediate and expert levels. Other shooting amenities include a quail walk-up, an English high-tower simulation and a state-of-the-art five-stand. World class hunting dogs and guides are also available to members year-round, as well as champion shooters for instruction.

Myers is no stranger to sporting clubs having developed Silver Hilton Lodge in British Columbia around North America’s finest wild steelhead fishery.
